On display will be weapons, bullets, artillery shells, and soldiers Civil war equipment. These relics have been excavated from private properties (with the land owners' permissions) mostly from the Gettysburg and Antietam Campaigns including Monterey Pass. Displayers will include members of the South Mountain Relic and Coin Club who will be available to describe their finds and tell stories of their relic hunting adventures.
