Joining the Greys are the 17th PA Cavalry who preserve the memory of a distinguished unit organized in 1862 at Harrisburg, commanded by Colonel Josiah H. Kellogg of Erie. The 17th PA will demonstrate and discuss tactics, techniques and procedures that provided Union and Confederate armies mobility for reconnaissance, defensive delaying tactics, pursuit of retreating forces.
