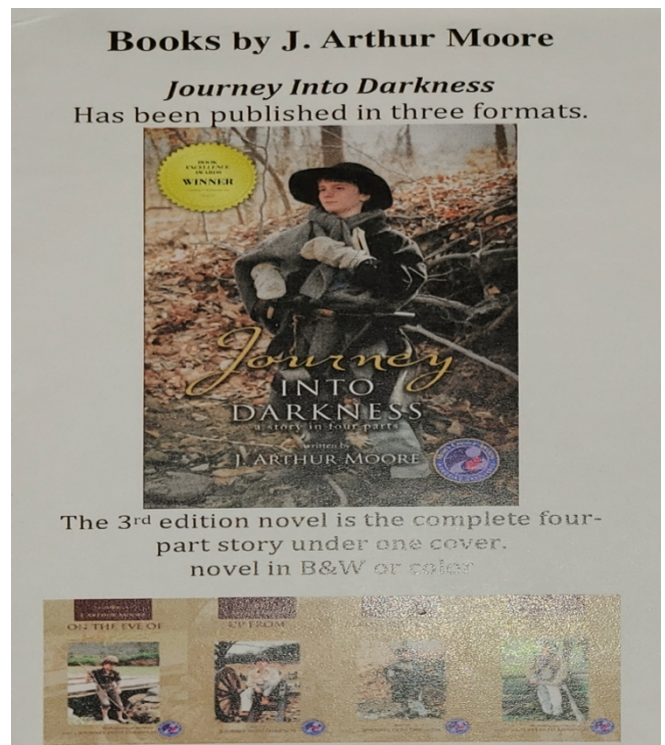
Apr 14-16, 9:30am - Present Unit Colors
