The Retreat that Led to the Battle



After three days of battle, General Lee needed to return to Virginia with his troops and the supplies that would enable them to fight another day. Over 20 miles of wagon train headed for Monterey Pass and a terrible battle, in a thunderstorm in the night.

Join the 1st North Carolina Sharpshooter Battalion, marching the rear guard path protecting the wagon train, from Fairfield to Monterey Pass.

- From 9am - 5pm Saturday, and 9am - 2pm Sunday, living historians will be present on Museum grounds with displays representing pursuing Federal forces, civilians, and other Civil War elements in the region.
- Between 12:00pm - 1:00pm, participants marching from Fairfield will be arriving on the grounds, times depending on march conditions.
