
The Retreat that Led to the Battle

After three days of battle, General Lee withdrew from Gettysburg for Virginia with troops and the supplies needed to fight another day.

Over 20 miles of wagon train headed for Monterey Pass and a terrible battle, in a thunderstorm, in the night.

North Carolina Sharpshooter Battalion, marching <u>the rear guard path</u> protecting the wagon train, from Fairfield to Monterey Pass. 50 reenactors will marshal in full uniform and packs at the Fairfield PA Fire Department, departing at 7:30 am for Monterey Pass Museum following the original retreat route where possible, arriving and estimated 12 - 1pm.

On July 6th (9am - 5 pm) and July 7th (9am - 2 pm), other living historians on the Museum grounds will offer their depiction of military camp life, medicine and local civilian life in the 1860s.

- On the 6th, infantry demonstrations will be at 10:30 am and 3:30 pm
- On the 7th, the 10th Mass will offer Military Camp Life discussions

Come experience this first Gettysburg Retreat reenactment.
